## RULES

### Mail in entries in advance of the Festival:

- If you are mailing more than one fleece entry, please place each fleece entry along with its paperwork in its own bag inside your box. **Fleeces that are not separated will not be offered for sale.**
- Please include a pre-paid mailing label (including tracking and insurance) for returning the entry (if unpurchased) if you do not plan on picking it up at the festival Sunday September 24<sup>th</sup> at 3 pm. **ANY MAILED ENTRY WITHOUT A WAY TO RETURN BECOMES PROPERTY OF THE LEHIGH VALLEY FIBER FESTIVAL. WE CONSIDER IT A DONATION, AND WILL SELL IT AT THE 2024 EVENT.**
- The Fleece Coordinator and the Lehigh Valley Fiber Festival will not be responsible for any fleece lost in transit.

## Walk in entries in advance of the Festival:

- Entries will be accepted Friday September 22, 2023 from 12 noon-6pm.
- Prior to submitting your entries, you MUST visit the information booth. You then will be directed to where to turn in your entry. Bring your fleece and application form together.
- Please include a pre-paid mailing label (including tracking and insurance) for returning the entry if you do not plan on picking it up at the festival Sunday September 24<sup>th</sup> between 2-3 pm. **ANY ENTRY NOT PICKED UP AND LEFT WITHOUT A WAY TO RETURN BECOMES PROPERTY OF THE LEHIGH VALLEY FIBER FESTIVAL. WE CONSIDER IT A DONATION, AND WILL SELL IT AT THE 2024 EVENT.**

## Commission:

- Lehigh Valley Fiber Festival retains a \$5 commission on each fleece sold. Please price your fleece accordingly.

## Entry Requirements:

- An entry shall consist of one fleece. There is no limit on the number or types of fleece that each person may enter.

## Divisions, Categories, and Classes

### Fleece Type:

- Sheep
- Alpaca
- Goat
- Rabbit

### Suggested Uses:

- Hand Spinners Delight – well skirted and clean top
- The Rugged Warrior- excellent choice for water felting to make rugs or cat nap pads
- Bound to Stick Together- needle or wet felting for hats, soap covers, dryer balls, etc.
- Millie's Best Friend- send I to your favourite mill to make into yarn or roving
- Lucy's Lovely Locks- great for doll's hair (or similar) or dyed locks
